13:30 Biodegradable Municipal Waste to Landfill Ban

The ban on Biodegradable Municipal Waste to landfill will come into force on 1 January 2021 in Scotland. SEPA is preparing to release guidance on what is covered by the ban at the end of April 2018. This session will cover the guidance and invite discussion on any queries or comments operators may have in relation to the Biodegradable Municipal Waste ban and guidance.

14:10 Landfill Restoration – New Guidance

SEPA is preparing to release guidance and Operator Notification forms for Landfill Restoration and associated plans. This session will provide an overview of the new guidance and forms and invite discussion.
